

Funding for international organisations and aid charities

Published by the Department for International Development 12 April 2020. DFID will provide £65 million for the World Health Organisation; £20 million for UNICEF; £20 million for the UN Refugee Agency (UNHCR); £15 million for the World Food Programme; £10 million for the UN Population Fund (UNFPA), £50 million for the new International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement appeals and £20 million for international NGOs, including UK charities, to tackle the virus and help prevent a second wave of coronavirus coming to the UK by slowing its spread in the most vulnerable countries
