

Food Charities Grant Fund

Published by the Department for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs on 11 May 2020. Front-line food aid charities can apply for a grant of up to £100,000 to help continue to provide food to the vulnerable. Applicants must be unable to meet an increased demand for food from vulnerable individuals and have the capacity to distribute all of the food purchased with the grant by 9 August 2020. The grant must be used to provide for people unable to afford food who have moved into temporary accommodation as a result of COVID-19. The grant cannot be used to provide food for the extremely clinically vulnerable, who are already being supported by government
