

Applying for the Coronavirus Local Authority Discretionary Grants Fund

Published by the Department for Business, Energy & Industrial Strategy on 29 May 2020. The Discretionary Grant Fund supports small and micro businesses that are not eligible for other grant schemes. eligible businesses must be based in England, have fewer than 50 employees, have fixed building costs such as rent, must have been trading on 11 March 2020 and is adversely impacted by the coronavirus pandemic. Eligible businesses must apply to their local authority. The government has asked local authorities to prioritise (inter alia) charity properties getting charitable business rates relief, which are not eligible for small business rates relief or rural rate relief
